Soechi Lines Hadiri Indonesia Maritime Week 2025

PT Soechi Lines Tbk (Kode Saham BEI: SOCI) selanjutnya disebut “**Perseroan**”, mendukung industri maritim nasional dengan berpartisipasi dalam konferensi maritim bertaraf internasional “**Indonesia Maritime Week 2025**”. Acara diselenggarakan pada 26-28 Mei 2025 di Jakarta International Convention Center, Jakarta, dengan dihadiri berbagai pelaku industri maritim global.

Direktur Utama Perseroan, Go Darmadi, menjadi salah satu pembicara di dalam acara, mendiskusikan tema “**Advancing Shipbuilding Capabilities in Asia**”. Pembicara lainnya dalam tema ini, ialah Anita Puji Utami selaku Ketua Umum Ikatan Perusahaan Industri Kapal dan Lepas Pantai Indonesia (IPERINDO), Arisudono Soerono selaku Direktur Utama PT Biro Klasifikasi Indonesia, Zhu Minghua selaku Vice President Jiangnan Shipyard (CSSC), You Weicheng selaku Survey Manager China Classification Society (CCS), dan Nova Y. Mugijanto dari Indonesian National Shipowners’ Association (INSA).

Diskusi membahas langkah yang perlu dilakukan Indonesia agar industri pembangunan kapal di dalam negeri dapat memiliki daya saing secara regional dalam jangka panjang. Diskusi juga membahas upaya harmonisasi standar internasional ke dalam kemampuan industri lokal saat ini, sehingga dapat memperkuat ekosistem pembangunan kapal dalam negeri khususnya pembangunan kapal yang berkelanjutan.

Perseroan sendiri melalui entitas anaknya, **PT Multi Ocean Shipyard (MOS)** telah menjadi bagian dari industri pembangunan kapal nasional dalam 16 tahun terakhir. Dalam perjalanan tersebut, MOS telah membangun berbagai jenis kapal untuk kebutuhan logistik di dalam negeri, diantaranya mencakup kapal tanker minyak dan avtur yang memiliki kapasitas ± 17.500 DWT, merupakan kapal terbesar dalam hal DWT kapal yang mana sejauh ini baru beberapa galangan kapal swasta di dalam negeri yang memiliki kapasitas dan kompetensi untuk membangun kapal dengan ukuran tersebut.

MOS juga telah membangun kapal tol laut, kapal navigasi, serta kapal survei untuk Pemerintah Indonesia, yang diinisiasi untuk memperkuat infrastruktur kemaritiman nasional dengan memperhatikan geografis Indonesia yang dua per tiganya merupakan area perairan. MOS juga sebelumnya mengerjakan pembangunan kapal rumah sakit untuk memperkuat infrastruktur kesehatan di wilayah perairan Indonesia.

Indonesia Maritime Week kali ini mengangkat tema **Asia's Maritime Leadership: Connectivity, Sustainability, and Digitalization**. Indonesia Maritime Week merupakan inisiatif strategis Kementerian Perhubungan bersama INSA, PT Pertamina International Shipping (PIS), dan PT Pelindo (Persero). Indonesia Maritime Week diharapkan dapat menjadi wadah pertemuan antara pemerintah, pelaku usaha, akademisi, serta berbagai pemangku kepentingan lainnya, untuk membicarakan isu-isu penting dan terkini sektor kemaritiman.

Acara Indonesia Maritime Week 2025 dibuka oleh Menteri Koordinator Bidang Infrastruktur dan Pembangunan Kewilayahan Republik Indonesia, Agus Harimurti Yudhoyono. Acara dihadiri oleh Sekretaris Jenderal Organisasi Maritim Internasional (IMO) Arsenio Dominguez Velasco, Ketua Umum INSA Carmelita Hartoto, dan berbagai pengusaha sektor maritim di Indonesia.

Soechi Lines melalui entitas anaknya merupakan pemilik dan operator kapal tanker di Indonesia, menyediakan layanan pengiriman minyak mentah maupun produk minyak dan gas. Armada tanker Perseroan utamanya disewakan kepada kontraktor minyak & gas yang beroperasi di Indonesia.

Soechi Lines melalui entitas anaknya juga memiliki dan mengoperasikan galangan kapal yang berlokasi di Tanjung Balai Karimun, Kepulauan Riau. Galangan kapal memiliki kemampuan untuk membangun kapal baru serta melakukan perbaikan dan perawatan kapal. Galangan kapal telah tersertifikasi hijau atas fasilitas daur ulang kapal yang dimiliki yang mana telah memenuhi standar keselamatan dan aspek lingkungan sesuai dengan IMO Hong Kong Convention.

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Soechi Lines Attends Indonesia Maritime Week 2025

PT Soechi Lines Tbk (IDX Stock Code: SOCI) hereinafter referred to as “**the Company**”, supports the national maritime industry by participating in the international maritime conference “**Indonesia Maritime Week 2025**”. The event is held on 26-28 May 2025 at Jakarta International Convention Center, Jakarta, attended by various global maritime industry stakeholders.

The Company’s President Director, Go Darmadi, is one of the speakers at the event, discussing the theme “**Advancing Shipbuilding Capabilities in Asia**”. Other speakers on this theme are Anita Puji Utami, Chairman of Indonesia Shipbuilding and Offshore Association (IPERINDO), Arisudono Soerono, President Director of PT Biro Klasifikasi Indonesia, Zhu Minghua, Vice President of Jiangnan Shipyard (CSSC), You Weicheng, Survey Manager of China Classification Society (CCS), and Nova Y. Mugijanto from Indonesian National Shipowners’ Association (INSA).

The discussion talks about the actions should Indonesia take to transform its shipbuilding industry into a competitive regional player within the long term. The discussion also goes into how to harmonize international standards with the current local industry capabilities, to strengthen the domestic shipbuilding ecosystem particularly in sustainable shipbuilding.

The Company itself, through its subsidiary, **PT Multi Ocean Shipyard (MOS)**, has been part of the national shipbuilding industry for the last 16 years. During its journey, MOS has built various types of ship to meet the domestic marine infrastructure requirements, which including to build the oil and avtur tankers of which capacity of ±17,500 DWT, the largest in term of ship’s DWT which so far only a few of private shipyards in the country have the capacity and competency to build ships with these capacities.

MOS has also built sea toll vessel, navigation vessels, and survey boats for the Indonesian Government, initiated to strengthen national maritime infrastructure as two-thirds of Indonesia's geography is water territory. MOS has previously built a hospital ship in order to support the Indonesian marine areas with sufficient health infrastructure.

This year's Indonesia Maritime Week carries the theme **Asia’s Maritime Leadership: Connectivity, Sustainability, and Digitalization**. Indonesia Maritime Week is a strategic initiative of the Ministry of Transportation together with INSA, PT Pertamina International Shipping (PIS), and PT Pelindo (Persero). Indonesia Maritime Week is expected to be a meeting point for the government, business doers, academics, and various other stakeholders, to discuss the important and latest issues in the maritime sector.

Indonesia Maritime Week 2025 was opened by the Coordinating Minister for Infrastructure and Regional Development of the Republic of Indonesia, Agus Harimurti Yudhoyono. The event is attended by the Secretary General of the International Maritime Organization (IMO) Arsenio Dominguez Velasco, Chairperson of INSA Carmelita Hartoto, and various maritime sector entrepreneurs in Indonesia.
